7. Complete follow up work, thank you letters, reports, etc, following LAC
8. Submit a report for the Executive Board of the issues discussed at the LAC Conference.
9. Keep legislative issues updated on the SNAU website.
10. Attend and serve as a voting member of the House of Delegates, or send an alternate if you cannot attend.
